The photo of the plaque does not do it justice. The plaque is A4 size. It is a mirrored brass plate on a bevelled edge timber backing with wall mountings.

The images are laser etched onto the plaque with words of your choosing. Each fellowship is numbered and Lions Hearing Dogs will mount the list of Fellowships issued on its web site. Where required other logos may be added.
